- 3. Student use of the Internet will be supervised and be electronically filtered.

- 5. Students are responsible for adhering to copyright guidelines.
- 6. Students are responsible for avoiding sites that are profane, obscene, or that advocate illegal acts, violence or discrimination towards other people.
- 7. General subject browsing, personal printing, personal e-mail, non-educational games, personal chat rooms, and downloading will not be allowed.
- 8. Violation of these Internet guidelines may include the immediate loss of computer use privileges.
